











# Pennington School Uniform Policy

All students attending Pennington School are required to wear a full school uniform during the school day and to designated school functions. All students must comply with the Pennington School Uniform Policy as well as the Prince William County School Dress Code. The School Administration and Teachers will determine if there is a violation of the uniform policy. A note from the teacher/administration will notify parents if the student is not dressed properly. Students not complying with the Uniform Policy will be required to change into something more appropriate and/or may be sent home to be properly prepared for school (see Level One infractions in student agenda). Students should dress in a modest and professional manner to demonstrate their respect for the school and for themselves. Therefore all students will abide by the following:

- All Shirts MUST be tucked in.
- Clothing must be appropriately sized for the wearer-NOT baggy OR tight fitting Clothing.
- No holes/tears or stains in clothing or shoes.
- Pants will be worn at the waistline.
- Belts must be worn when beltloops are present.
- All shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers will be worn at vendor length that is not shorter than five (5) inches above the knee.

Pennington uses Lands End uniforms as it's style and color guide. However, pieces may be purchased from other vendors. Keep in mind that they must match in style and color to the Pennington Uniform Policy herein. Fabric swatches are available at the school office and thru Lands End. Only the Pennington School logo will be permitted on uniforms. For an additional cost, Lands End and French Toast can embroider the school logo. 	<p><b>PANTS &amp; SHORTS</b> are permitted in three waist styles: flat front, pleated front and elastic waist. All pants are to have straight legs. Both pants and shorts can be cuffed or uncuffed. Not allowed are tight fitting, baggies, short-shorts, cargos, cropped, flare-leg, frayed edges, or decorative pockets. This applies to <b>ALL GRADE LEVELS</b>.</p>	<p>Khaki Classic Navy</p>

**Belts** MUST be worn when belt loops are present. They can be Navy, Brown, Black or White.  
**Socks/Tights** must be worn at all times and be of a color in the school uniform. They are to be solid or a conservative pattern.  
**Shoes/Sneakers** must have enclosed heel and toes and must be in good condition. If laces are present they must be tied. No wheels (Heelies™).  
**PE Uniforms** (for Grades 6 – 8 only) must be purchased through Pennington School PE department. They consist of navy shorts and light gray t-shirt and are to be worn only on specified PE days. Tennis shoes/Sneakers must be worn on PE days.  
**Spirit Wear Sweatpants and Sweatshirts** can be purchased from the school PE department and are available to all grades. Spirit Wear is NOT part of the Pennington uniform but can be worn over middle school PE uniforms in inclement/cold weather.  
**Head Coverings** such as hats, scarves, or caps are not allowed, unless related to one's religious belief or practice.

**Ties and Cross Ties** are optional in Navy, Evergreen and Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid.  
**Hair Accessories** are optional and are of the students' choosing but should coordinate to the uniform colors. Some vendors carry hairbands and scrunchies in the school approved colors and plaid (Lands End, French Toast). Hair color should be consistent with the natural shades of hair. Hair styles/color should uphold the integrity of the traditional school environment.  
**Jewelry** should be minimal/moderate in size and amounts for boys and girls. Earrings are to be worn in ears only.  
 There are no set guidelines for **Coats and Outerwear**, except that students are not permitted to wear long trench coats or over-sized coats within the school building in accordance with Prince William County Dress Code and Code of Behavior Policy.  
**Backpacks** are of the students' choosing, except that wheeled backpacks are not permitted.
